

OFFICIAL Minutes  
Town of Westford October Meeting  
October 5, 2023 @ 7:00 pm

The Town of Westford conducted its October Meeting on October 5th, 2023 @ 7pm. The Board meeting was at the Historic St. Anthony School, 32497 CTH "V", IN CAZENOVIA.

The agenda is as follows:

- 1) Call to Order Time: 7:02pm Ursula not present.
- 2) Pledge of Allegiance
- 3) Minutes from September 2023 meeting. Motion to Approve by Gary 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cy, Concurred by Frank
- 4) Citizen's concerns and contacts – none
- 5) Review of Ladika Property on CTH "I". The Board was contacted by Ladika's attorney. The Board reaffirms the position that they purchasers of the land need to obtain proper permits before building any structures. Gary reaffirms and motions: Buildings places on the parcels need a permit. Cy second and Frank Concurred. Ladika's do not want any extra wording on the deed. We are taking our language off. Gary signed and certified the survey maps, so this issue can be closed. All wording will come from the county.
- 6) Request of L. Klang on property use on CTH "V" (no address) Nick would like to build a home, possibly on 88 acres. The Board sees no reason to oppose. They will need a driveway permit and must be approved by any DNR and county ordinances/permits. Frank motioned to accept the build of a new residential home if it is not in a flood plain. Cy 2<sup>nd</sup>, and Gary concurred.
- 7) Reports by Supervisors: Cy: Received a check for the Veteran's Graves and deposited it.  
Frank: Campground ordinance, Blake was supposed to put this together. Put this on the agenda for next month.  
Clerk: Will investigate the Wi-Fi for the meetings/voting. I request a new printer and put my present one at St. A's Center; and purchase desk dividers for voting privacy.  
Chair: Deposit from Gary for phone repair \$75. Mentioned Nate could take the boom-mower for Klang Drive, and Cunningham Ridge Road to cut back overhang. Nate would prefer the bucket truck and will do as much as he can including Hawkins Creek Rd and Fry Rds. Missy needs to attend the planning and zoning meetings as far as the campground, then will attend Richland County meetings if needed.  
Treasurer: Gave bank reports.  
Foreman: 2 dumpsters for trash and 1 for recycling metal will come for the clean up day. The St. Bridget's Cemetery post is ordered from Decker Signs. Hanko Drive has a low spot he would like to patch, may cost \$500-\$700, Gary agreed. Snow tires were priced and Hartje had the best price for the Sterling Truck. \$446.10 each. (Bindl was \$450)
