The Town Board of the Westford Township's July 2026 monthly meeting on July 2nd, 2026, at 7:00 pm. The meeting was held at the Historic St. Anthony's School, 32497 CTH "V", in the unincorporated community of Germantown in the Westford Township. The agenda was as follows:

- Pledge of Allegiance
- Approved of June 2026 minutes
- Citizen concerns and comments
 - Sandra Kramer informed the board about the County EMT/EMS. They will be inoperative on 1/1/28. Our levy will increase over \$40K (3.514% increase) to cover the Townships that have no coverage. This means our Townspeople's taxes will be raised. This includes the cost for the EMS towers and dispatch. More residents need to attend the County Board Meetings.
 - Carol Gilber, Election Chief, notified the board of the next election on August 11th and said Cy doesn't have to help. We will have 4 total poll workers and would like to have them paid that evening. The Pre-Lat and Public test will be at the end of July and the beginning of August.
 - Scott, VP of Jewel Inc., writes grants for several Wisconsin townships, villages, and cities. The cost is \$500 per grant, and he is happy to help.
- Discussed creating Resolutions/Ordinances, but paperwork needed to be created:
 - Adopt NO Data Centers in the Town of Westford
 - Adopt NO Commercial Windmills in the Town of Westford
 - Adopt NO Additional Power Lines in the Town of Westford
 - Adopt the Room Tax for the Town of Westford

- Adopted the Farmland Preservation Map
- Discussed the town phone choices for an upgrade, cancelling all but 2 and upgrading to cell phones.
- Reports by Board Members
 - Ann, accounts are current, taxes will be able to be paid on-line
 - Nathan, Bunker Hill Rd is being repaired, and milestone is supplying the gravel. Henrietta Township will be repairing Ryan Rd and will have Jason F. bill Westford for our part of the road.
 - Cy attended County Unit meeting with Ursula to learn more about the EMS issues for Richland County.
 - Ursula attended added Unit meetings learning that Westford Residents will have a tax increase to cover the costs of Richland County EMS even though they do not service our area. Townships are trying to create a District to receive a grant to start their own service. This will take 1.5 yrs to carry out.
